



Acknowledgements





Funding Availability

One year funding (July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027).

Potential to renew contracts for up to an additional two years based on performance and funding availability (renewal process announced in early 2027).

Grants in range of \$50,000 - \$200,000.

Agencies can change the amount between the Letter of Intent and Application, if invited, but it must be reasonably similar to the original proposal.




Eligibility

Non-profit, governmental, and public organizations are eligible to apply. Organizations without non-profit status may apply through a fiscal sponsor.

Each organization may submit only one (1) application.

Projects must address disparities in health access or outcomes for underserved communities. Health is defined broadly, including medical, behavioral or mental health, nutrition, fitness, and health education.



Project Type

Service Delivery

Services funded by the grant must be delivered within King County, though clients and patients may reside outside the county.

Advocacy

Projects may focus on King County or extend to broader, including statewide, initiatives.

Program Evaluation

Limited to community-based health projects, not solely academic research.


Log On or Create a New Account

Complete the LOI application form.



Click “Submit” before 12:00 PM (noon) on January 26.

Questions about the LOI application process and program eligibility must be submitted by **5:00 pm on Tuesday January 22, 2026.**

How will your proposed program address the identified health outcome or access disparity?


- Briefly describe the program activities and explain how they directly address the identified issue.



Narrative Questions: Question 3:

What will be the short and long-term health impact of the program?

- Please include information on the size of the population that will be reached, as well as quantitative and qualitative goals.



Application Narrative

Write your proposal for reviewers who are **unfamiliar** with your agency and your proposed program.

Be clear and concise in your writing; try to avoid jargon and undefined acronyms.

Include **quantifiable** information about access and outcome disparities, clients to be served, and services provided. Use as much relevant **data** as possible.

Define why you've chosen the **populations and services** you're proposing and why you're the **appropriate agency** to deliver the program.

Applications cannot be submitted after the deadline and will not be considered. No exceptions will be made.
